This is the reason why French readers, subscribers to the JMV, will find a link in this issue that will allow them to find, on the site of the French College of Vascular Pathology, a synthesis in French of this issue. But the goal is not only to publish the articles of French authors in English. It is also to broaden the editorial board of the JMV to make it an international editorial

committee and thus to offer authors from all continents the means to publish their work in the columns of the JMV. Vascular medicine has been a specialty in France since 2015. It is a dynamic specialty that deserves a journal of expression that is just as much. The publication in this issue of the guidelines proposed by The International Initiative on Thrombosis and Cancer (ITAC) is a good example of international cooperative work such as the JMV wishes to publish.
